The dawn of a New Year is upon us and my wish for each and everyone is a Happy, Healthy, and Prosperous New Year.

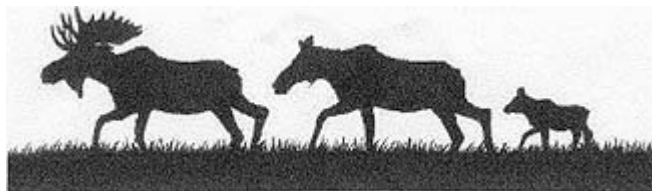
