Sympathy is extended to the family of Collegian, Eva Morrison who passed away . Sympathy is also extended to Donna Gardner on the recent loss of her loved ones.

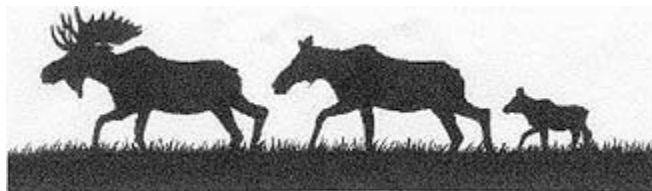
Thanks you to those coworkers who made food for the Moose Riders. They appreciated our help and enjoyed the many dishes that were prepared.
