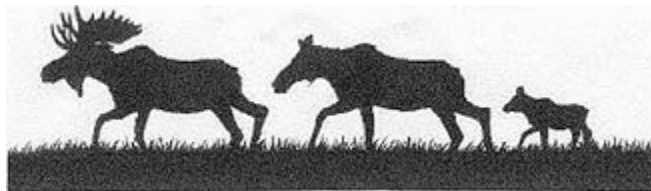
The Chapter will be hosting an indoor yard and craft sale again in the lodge hall on Oct 15th, 2011. If your interested in a table see the chapter members for all the info.
